Richard Kim is currently the Head of Global Design for Faraday Future (FF) where he oversees all aspects of design for FF products and the brand. Prior to joining FF, Richard recently managed the design team for Special Programs & Group Design: Audi, Bentley, Porsche at the VW Group Design Center California. Richard joined the BMW Group in 2005 where he was responsible for creating automotive and transportation design solutions. In 2008, Richard was one of the lead designers and a founding member of the BMW i team where he focused on the visionary BMW i3 production vehicle. He relocated to Munich, Germany in 2010 to lead the design, build, and support press launches for the BMW i3 and BMW i8 concepts debuted at the IAA Frankfurt Auto Show. In the following year, Richard's design for the BMW i8 Spyder Concept was unveiled at the Beijing Auto Show. Outside of BMW Group programs, Richard has worked on private jet interiors for Embraer and luxury yachts for Intermarine under Designworks USA, a subsidiary of BMW. Richard Kim started his career as a designer with Audi VW Group's Design Center Europe in Barcelona. Richard has served as a faculty member at the Art Center College of Design since 2007.
